To begin this week at school we started talking about the letter "B". We talked about the sound of the letter and made a list of things that began with the letter. During our craft time on Tuesday, we made spooky bats out of the letter "B".

We talked about things that we might see around Halloween time, including ghosts, costumes, candy, witches, decorations, spiders, etc. Some of our crafts this week included jack 'o lanterns, ghosts, and witches. Next week we will continue to learn about all kinds of spooky things.

During our center time, we introduced some fun, new Halloween-themed games. We practiced our number recognition with a spider-web roll. During this game, students were required to roll a large foam die, count the dots on the side it landed on, and then cover up the matching number on a spider web provided with a spooky googly eye. We also had lots of fun in our sensory table with purple, black, and orange colored rice. In the rice bins there were skeletons, spiders, centipedes, and mummies.
